About Us

<u>The Compost Co-operative</u> is a worker-owned co-op that provides residential and commercial pick ups of food scraps and other organic materials to be delivered to composting facilities. They are driven by environmental and racial justice and are committed to providing opportunities for ownership, meaningful work, and housing for folks impacted by incarceration.

Oxbow Design Build is a full-service design and construction cooperative committed to supporting the community and anchoring their construction practices in sustainability. Devoted to sourcing materials and services locally whenever possible, they are constantly aiming to build a sustainable, local, and worker-centered economy.

About the Project

The Compost Co-op and Oxbow have teamed up to realize the dream of creating opportunities to live in safety for folks who have faced financial and other barriers to housing. We are in the process of purchasing a 2-unit building in downtown Greenfield. This property will be reinvisioned and redesigned to feature 3 units with efficiency and sustainability prioritized. This property is an excellent candidate for solar installation!

This is just the beginning! Conversations continue and the vision of cooperative land stewardship on a larger scale is continuing to develop.
